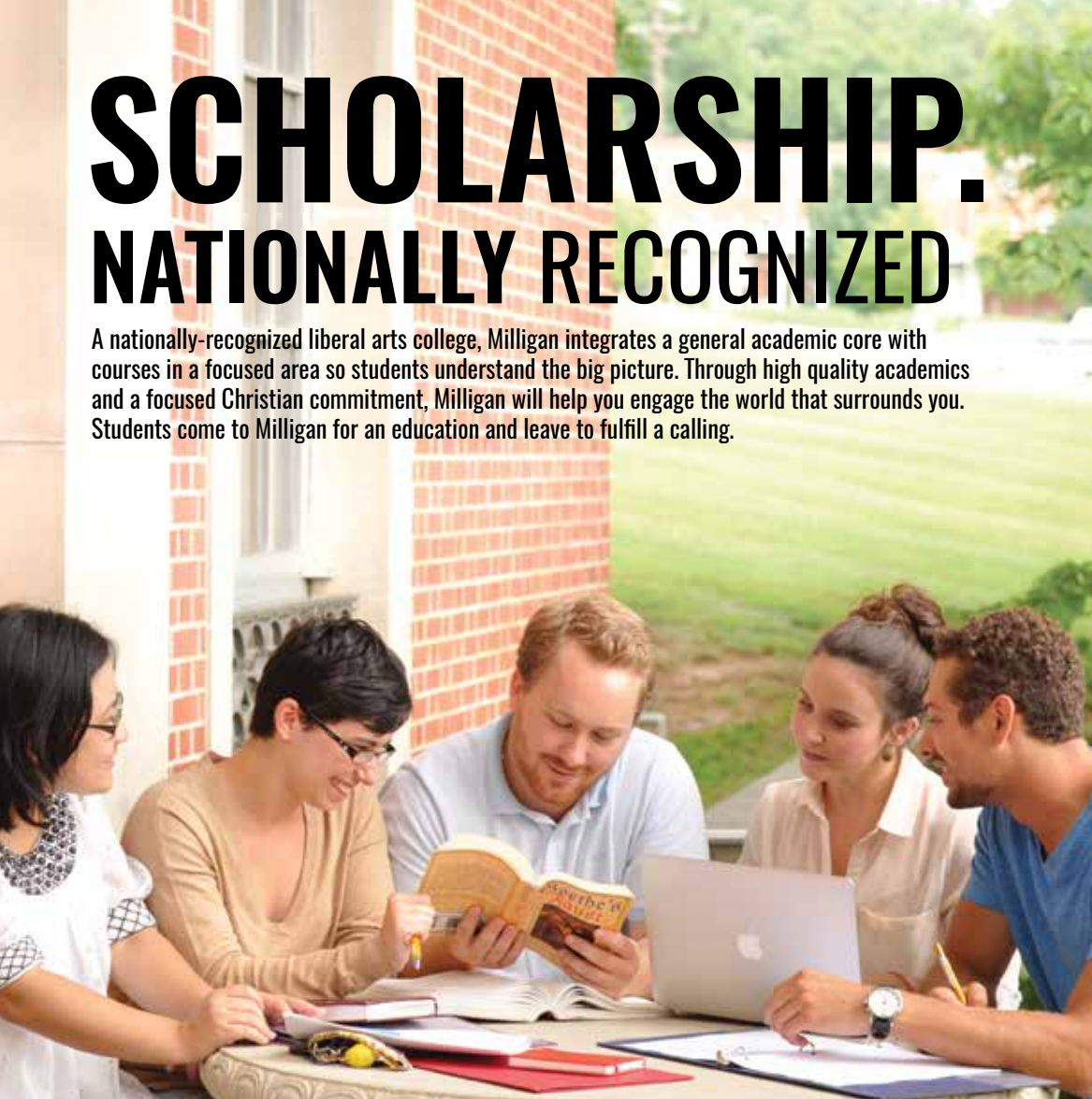


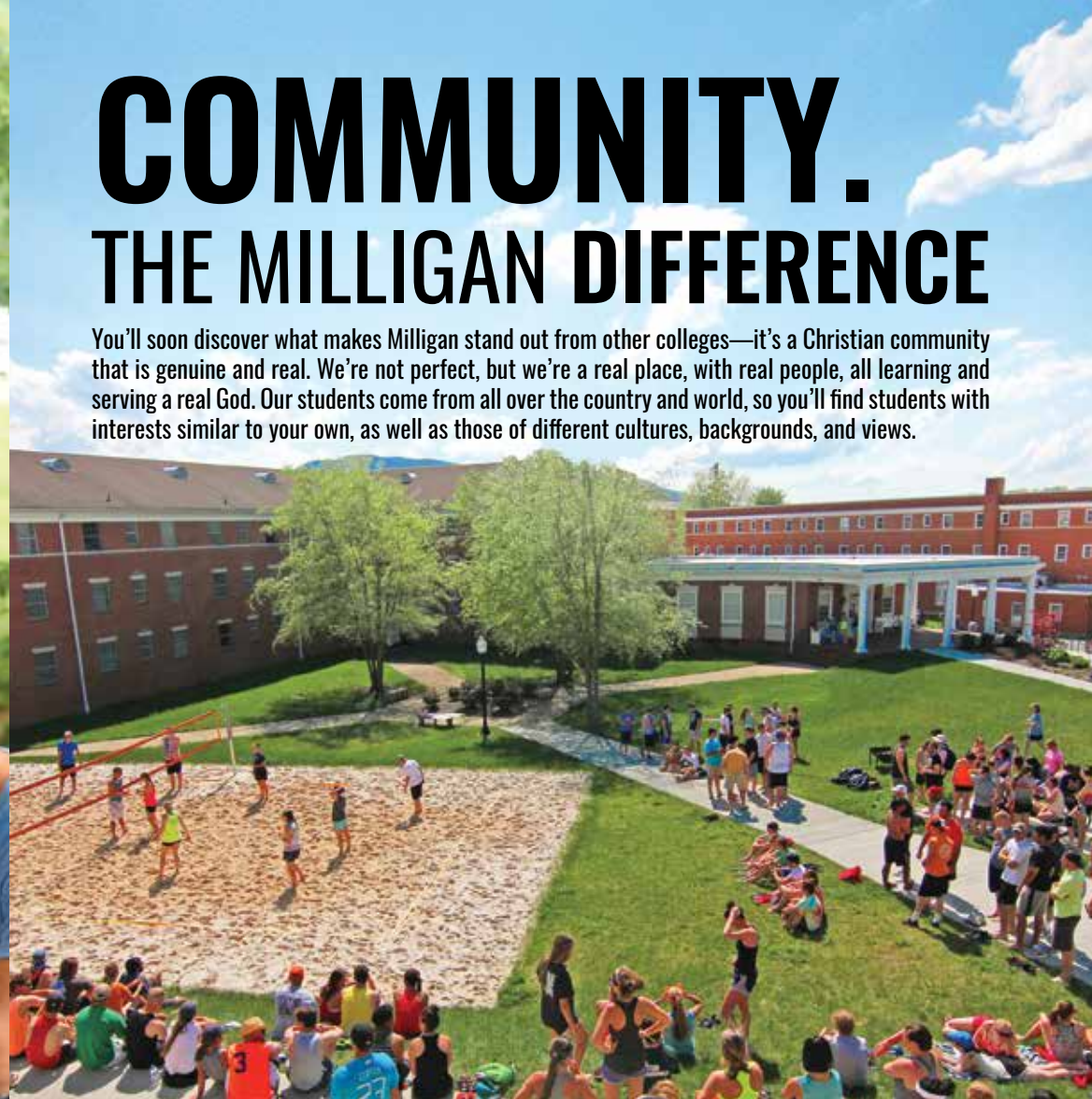

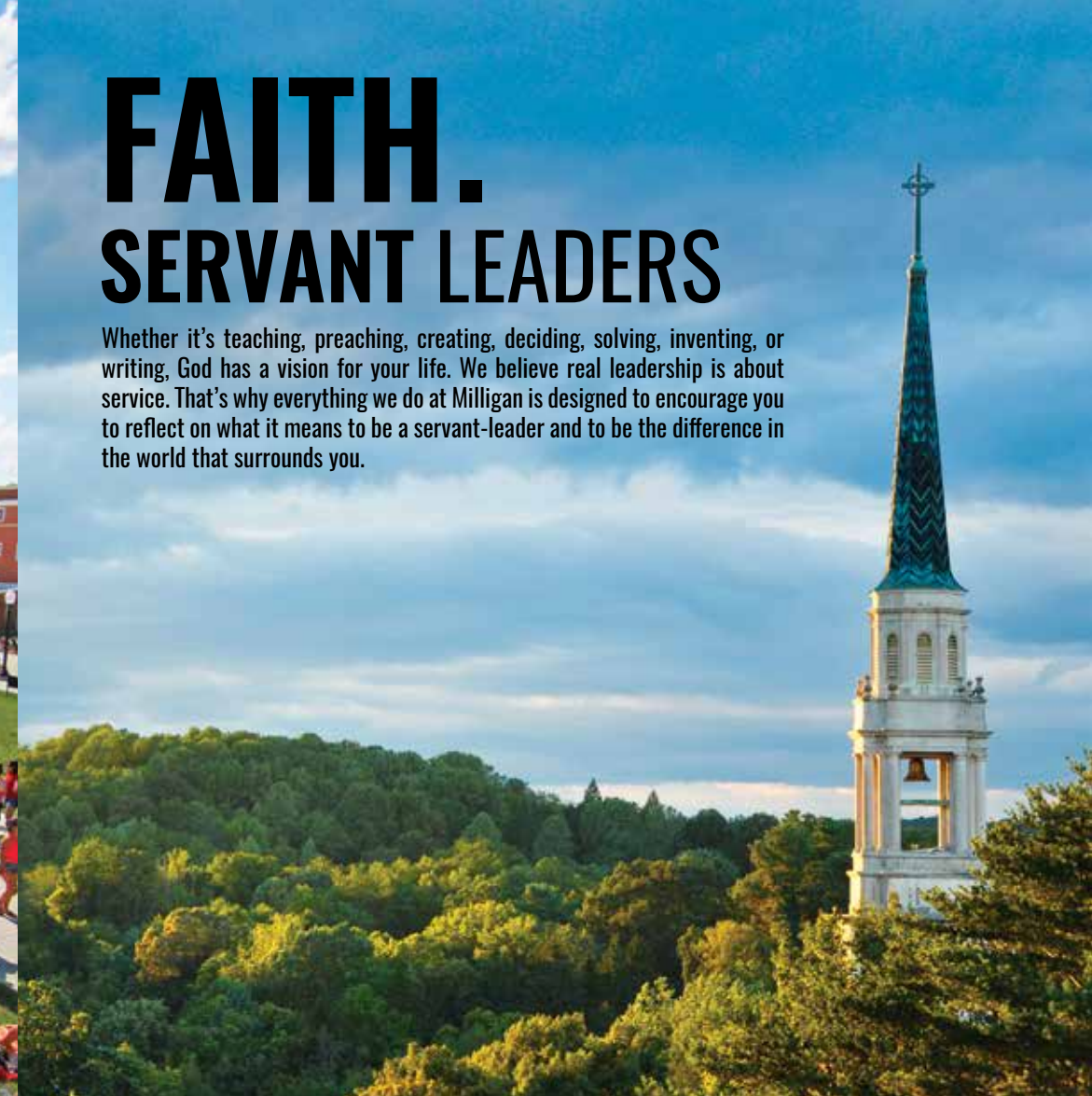
COMMUNITY. THE MILLIGAN DIFFERENCE
